Discussion Questions for the sermon "Proper Attitude for Serving God" on January 16, 2011

1. Share an instance in which you received good service because the person serving you had a good attitude or an instance in which you received bad service because the person serving you had a bad attitude. How did you know this person had a good or bad attitude? How did this experience influence your desire and decision to receive service from this person again?
2. How important is one's attitude when it comes to serving God? Explain.
3. What do you consider to be a good attitude when it comes to serving God?
4. Read 1 Peter 5:1-4.
5. Whom does 1 Peter 5:1-4 address directly?
6. What is an elder?
7. How is this passage relevant to those of us who are not elders?
8. What are the three characteristics of a proper attitude for serving God?
9. Which one of the three characteristics can you relate with the most, and why?
10. Which one of the three characteristics do you struggle with the most, and why?
11. Which one of the three characteristics do you want to work on the most, and why? How do you plan to do that?
12. What reward awaits us when we serve God properly? How does this reward motivate you?
13. Are you currently serving God? If the answer is no, share with your group about what is making it difficult for you to serve. If the answer is yes, share with your group about what you are doing to serve God and the difficulties you encounter in doing that.
14. Close this time with prayer. Pray for those who are not currently serving to overcome their difficulties and start serving God in some realistic and reasonable ways. Pray for those who are

already serving to have the proper attitude for serving, and for God's help to overcome and persevere in their difficulties.
